**Description**

These figures include all Student Housing and Hospitality Services (SHHS) and non-SHHS student housing located on the Vancouver campus (on both Academic and neighbourhood lands), and all SHHS housing in the Okanagan campus. On the Vancouver campus, only 50% of theological student residences are included in above totals. This is based on the assumption that approximately 50% of theological residences are home to UBC students and the other 50% are home to theological college affiliates.

**Explanation of Results**

Over the past 5 years UBC's Vancouver campus has seen an increase in about 800 or 8% new student beds. UBC's Okanagan campus has seen an increase of about 700 beds or 40% over the last five years.

No new units of student housing were completed at either UBC's Okanagan or Vancouver campuses in 2012/13. The increase in student beds from 2011/12 - 2012/13 on the Vancouver campus is accounted for by the transfer of 269 units of staff/faculty housing to the student family inventory.

**Recommended Action**

Continue to develop student housing on both campuses in response to demand and as UBC's financial resources allow, in recognition of the importance of on-campus housing to students' academic success and experience and the university's sustainability goals. The Ponderosa Commons Phase 1 will add approximately 400 beds at the Vancouver Campus in August 2013 and 203 by December 2013.
